The National Health Service was large-scale even at the start, and is somewhat larger today. The population of England, Scotland, and Wales is about fifty million, of whom some 97 per cent have joined the NHS as patients. An estimated 98 per cent of both the 23,000 doctors in general practice and the 7,800 consultant-specialists, and about the same percentage of all persons in general dental practice, have joined on either a full-time or part-time basis. The British people have always welcomed foreigners who wanted to study their National Health Service, though they have sometimes been rather puzzled by the results. In his scholarly history of the NHS, Sir James Ross comments on reports about the Service that have been published in the United States. The National Health Service Act 1946 (c 81) came into effect on 5 July 1948 and created the National Health Service in England and Wales thus being the first implementation of the Beveridge model. Though the title 'National Health Service' implies a single health service for the United Kingdom, in reality one NHS was created for England and Wales accountable to the Secretary of State for Health, with a separate NHS created for Scotland accountable to the Secretary of State for Scotland by the passage The National Health Service.
