American historian and political scientist Robert Paxton, a scholar on the topic of fascism, has rejected the idea that there have been indigenous fascist movements in Africa, claiming that there have been no prominent examples of fascist regimes amongst Third World. It would seem that Fascism and Imperialism are absent a free society and a government limited by that society. Capitalism is predicated upon a free society and a limited government. 2. There is also no evidence to suggest that Fascism in Germany and Italy, worked for the interests of the upper classes. A. James Gregor, a political scientist who studied Fascism in-depth, stated in 2006, "Fascism never served the interests of Italian business . . . there is no credible evidence that Fascism controlled the nation's economy for the benefit of the 'possessing classes'". Likewise, Peter Drucker, an American writer and university professor, stated in 1939, "It is not true that 'big business' promoted Fascism. Mamdani cautions against seeing fascism in Uganda as a result of the individual, Idi Amin. Instead, he sees Idi Amin himself as a product of the specific conditions of the country at the time, which arose from a specific historical context, colonialism.
