Its prophecies of world-ruling empires are closely related to Revelation.^Å While we have already noted that the book of Daniel is referred to in New Testament prophecy more than any other Old Testament book, it is significant to note that Jesus also referred to this book. In one of His most famous prophecies, Jesus commented on *“the abomination of desolation,”*TM spoken of by Daniel the prophet^Å (Matthew 24:15).
